Pennock City Council held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, March 2, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. at the Pennock Community Center. The following members were present Mayor Kevin Crowley, Council members Jeff Arends, Bruce Bastin, Dave Miller and Karen Skaggs. Also present was Donavan Peters and Deputy Riley Kampsen.

Mayor Crowley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Motion by Council member Bastin to accept the Agenda as presented, Council member Arends seconds the motion. The motion passed.

Streetlights along Horseshoe Drive NW – It was said that Ottertail will put two lights at the end of Horseshoe Drive along Atlantic Ave NW and put others in as the lots are sold and houses are put in.
