

Pennock City Council Meeting  
Tuesday, April 7, 2015

Pennock City Council held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, April 7, 2015 at 5:30 p.m. at the Pennock Community Center. The following members were present Mayor Kevin Crowley, Council members Dave Miller, Jeff Arends, Bruce Bastin and Terry Thole. Also present were Gaylen Thompson, Deputy Ross Johnson, Nancy Stredde, Larry VanHout and Craig Tschida with WSN (Widseth Smith Nolting), Shawn Mulhern with KLM Engineering Inc. and resident Mike Schackman.

Mayor Crowley called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Motion by Council member Arends to approve the March 3<sup>rd</sup> Council minutes, Council member Bastin seconds the motion. The motion passed.

The bills were presented. Motion by Council member Thole to pay all the bills; Council member Miller seconds the motion. The motion passed.

Deputy Ross Johnson presented the sheriff's report. For the month of February there were 54 hours and for the month of March there were 64 hours.

Nancy Stredde presented the council with a tentative schedule for Pennock Fun Days. The next Pennock Fun Days meeting is Wednesday, April 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. at the Pit Stop.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

Larry VanHout with WSN (Widseth Smith Nolting) updated the council as to the steps that have been taken on the Elevated Water Storage Tank. WSN is presently waiting for the MN Department of Health approval letter. Motion by Council member Miller to authorize WSN to request for bids for the Elevated Water Storage Tank project; Council member Bastin seconds the motion. The motion passed.

Clerk Johnson presented an estimate as to what it would cost for the tree planting project along Atlantic Avenue NW. Motion by Council member Bastin to proceed with the tree planting; Council member Thole seconds the motion. The motion passed.

The Pennock City Wide Clean-up Day for city residents of Pennock is scheduled for May 16<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. for City of Pennock residents. There will be a \$5.00 charge per appliance for any non-city resident. Batteries will be accepted. **NO TIRES or FLOURESCENT LIGHTS ALLOWED.**
